CARS, TRUCKS, MOTORCYCLES, & CYCLISTS SHARE RIGHTS & RULES ON THE BOAD

LANE USAGE

Bikes ride as far right as possible except for the following situations:

When passing another bike or car.

When preparing to turn left.

When avoiding hazzards such as: glass, potholes, pedestrians, lack of a shoulder or shared lane, etc...

RIDING SIDE BY SIDE

As long as cars have space to pass, riding two abreast is allowed.

HAND SIGNALS

Cyclists point in the direction of intended turn.

A downward arm means slowing/stopping.

PASSING A CYCLIST

Cars must allow **3** Feet of space when passing a bicycle.

PARKING

Do not park in a marked bike lane.

Car doors can be deadly. Always check for cyclists before opening your car door.

SAFETY

Bikes must have front and rear lights when riding at night. Helmets, while not legaly required, are strongly encouraged.
