CARS & CYCLISTS FOLLOW THE SAME TRAFFIC LAWS

LANE USAGE

Bikes ride as far right as practicable **except for the following situations**:

When passing another bike or car.

When preparing to turn left.

When avoiding hazards such as: glass, potholes, pedestrians, ice, opening car doors, lack of a shoulder or shared lane, etc...

Bicycles have the right to use the entire lane if it is too narrow for a bike and car to be side by side without **3** feet of space in between

As long as cars have space to pass, riding two abreast is allowed.

PASSING A CYCLIST

Cars **must** allow **3 feet** of space when passing a bicycle. Cyclists and cars pass on the **left only**.

SAFETY

Bikes must have front and rear lights when riding at night. Helmets, while not legaly required, are strongly encouraged.

HAND SIGNALS

Cyclists point in the direction of intended turn. A downward arm means slowing or stopping

PARKING

Do not park in a marked bike lane. Car doors can be deadly. Always check for cyclists before opening your car door. a chicago bicycling online community
